- The group is to focus on a specific section of the newspaper and create articles, find pictures, and make advertisements for that section
- Articles will be typed, double spaced, 14pt font
- This is not a “history paper” I want you to write an article that shows the evidence of being a reporter
 - Be objective
 - State the facts (Report as if it was real time, you do not know the outcome)
 - Give details
- Be creative, be entertaining. You can use cultural aspects and make fictitious articles for some of the sections.
- Be sure to create a headline for your article. Length will be determined by section and article choice.
- You must show your research notes for your story as well as the final copy.
- A works consulted page needs to be placed with the assignment. In-text citations are also required. This assignment will only use the links from Mrs. King and Classroom Notes.
- You may do an additional article for extra credit.

Local Section:

Regional: 2 articles 300 words minimum +2 pictures

Letters to Editor: 3 articles 200 words minimum

Weather: Actual forecast; 5 day forecast; maps; weather symbols; minimum 5 key cities

Sports:

Local: 2 articles 150 words minimum +2 pictures

International: 2 articles 150 words minimum +2 pictures

Board Games: Explain rules, progression of game, include diagrams

Business:

Reviews: 2 articles 100 words minimum +4 pictures

Stock Market Reports: Create a list of a minimum of 15 tradable materials from the era, include minimum of 10 pictures

Technology: 2 articles 150 words minimum + 2 pictures

Obituaries:

4 Famous Obituaries; 4 common people 100 words minimum

Classified Ads:

Post for Jobs: 4 Jobs 100 words minimum +2 pictures

Personal Ads: 4 Personals 100 words minimum +2 pictures

Travel:

Within Empire: 2 articles 200 words minimum +2 pictures

Outside Empire: 2 articles 200 words minimum +2 pictures

Entertainment:

Food Recipes: 5 authentic recipes + pictures of ingredients

Fashion: 2 articles 150 words + 2 pictures

Reviews: 2 reviews of actual plays/books 200 words
